Dear Pastors and Leaders,

I want to provide an update of what has been happening since the Pastor's Prayer Luncheon on November 14th at Crandall University. We continue to appreciate any participation and feedback. The Leadership Team has been hard at work organizing your thoughts and desire to see a prayer initiative in our area into something we are calling the **Rising Tide Prayer Movement**.
